Thank you for your support of RV4CampfireFamily now EmergencyRV.org. I wanted to provide some updates and make an appeal for your additional support.

Since that first RV that Luna and I drove from Colorado to California in 2018, we have continued our work helping families who fall through the cracks of traditional relief organizations. We provide RVs to serve as transitional shelters for survivors of natural disasters. Thanks to your support, we have now provided this critical basic need, shelter, to over 120 families.

This past year we delivered RVs to firefighters and front-line medical workers who lost homes to tornados in Kentucky, and wildfires in Kansas, California and Colorado. We also delivered RVs and re-building supplies last Thanksgiving to Native American families who lost homes deep in the Bayou of southern Louisiana. Just a couple of weeks ago on Sept. 11, we delivered RVs to a California firefighter family and an 82-year-old Vietnam veteran and his 84-year-old wife who had no housing options after losing their home to the #oakfire.

We want to make an appeal for your immediate financial support as we have multiple firefighters and families who have contacted us recently with a desperate need for shelter, having lost everything recently in California to the #Oakfire, #Mosquitofire and #McKinneyfire. We are also starting to hear from families in desperate need of shelter following Hurricane Ian in Florida.

We currently have RVs on hand in California but need your support with the cost to make ready and deliver the RVs. Our fundraising goal is \$15,000, and your donation of any amount will help us stock these RVs with items the families will need to get back on their feet again and help us transport the RV's to their final location. Great news is that we just heard from a long time donor who will match up to \$5,000.00 in donations so hoping we can reach our goal quickly and get back the work of helping these families.
